EXTREME WEATHER POLICY

Preamble:

The Geelong District Veterans Golf Association Incorporated (known as GDVGA) is a district association and as such does not have a home golf course. The GDVGA plays at many courses within the Geelong District and as such must comply with the rules, regulations, and policies of these individual clubs.

The GDVGA has a duty of care to its members and as such has developed this extreme weather policy in accordance with the Golf Australia extreme weather guidelines. In circumstances of extreme hot weather conditions, the assessment of such conditions will be undertaken with reference to temperature and humidity information provided by the Bureau of Meteorology. Extreme weather may be defined as weather that threatens the immediate or long-term safety of individuals and as a result events are likely to be cancelled, postponed or modified.

Policy:

At 1:00pm on the day before the competition, should the Bureau of Meteorology (BOM) website forecasted temperature for the scheduled venue be 34⁰ Celsius or higher, the event will be cancelled.

This policy has been ratified by the GDVGA Committee at the meeting held on 13/02/25 and will come into effect from that date.
